Message: Self Denial....The Turn From Me To You! Scripture: Mark 8. 31-38 NIV. Revelation 12. 7-12. NIV.

"Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."

Leo Tolstoy wrote, "The right path in life is very narrow, but it is important to find it. You can understand it, as well as we can understand it, as a walkway of wood built across a swamp; if you



step off it, you will plunge into a swamp of misunderstanding and evil. A wise man returns to the true path at once, but a weak man plunges further and further into the swamp, and it becomes more and more difficult for him to get out."

The walkway of wood built across the swamp of life is the way of the cross, and it is one we all choose whether or not we will follow.

A Prayer Based on Philippians 1:18-30

Holy Spirit, make me so dead to self and so embracing of the cross that I have no shame on judgement day in how I handled difficulty, self-denial, persecution, misunderstanding, sacrifice, suffering and the burdens of life and ministry.

Re-Jesus: A Wild Messiah for a Missional Church

The phrase 'Re-Jesus' was first introduced in a book by two Aussies:

Michael Frost and Alan Hirsh. 'Re' is the prefix to denote doing something again or going back to it such as re-visit, re-discover and re-ignite.

In their book, Frost and Hirsh challenge us to re-align our lives, churches, and organizations with the biblical Jesus.

From their perspective, Western Christians take their cues more from their culture than from Jesus. Their observations call us to consider these vital questions:

How close or how far are we from Jesus' pattern of doing global missions – making disciples of the nations?

Has Western Christianity dulled our ability to reflect Jesus' manner and way of living life on-mission?



If yes, how do we 'Re-Jesus' our lives, our church and our mission?

To answer this question, we need to latch on to Jesus as He walks the neighbourhoods of His time. I have decided to do just that – re-read the Gospel of Mark as part of Lent and rediscover the Jesus' way of living. I thought you may like to go on the journey with me.
