

<u>Theme</u>: Pentecost and The Holy Spirit <u>Bible Reading</u>: Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:3-5; Acts 2:1-39; (ESV)

Pentecost was originally a Greek word πεντηκοστή, (*pentēkostē*), literally meaning "fiftieth". In this case, fifty days after Passover. Pentecost was an important Jewish festival that remembered God giving the Torah at Mt Sinai after the Israelites escaped Egypt.

Just as the story of the Passover and being gifted the Torah foreshadows Jesus' sacrifice and the gift of the Holy Spirit, so the manner of the Holy Spirit's appearance is foreshadowed through the Old Testament, where the Holy Spirit's presence and action is often symbolised by wind, cloud, or fire.

But ... why were the disciples 'speaking in tongues'? Pentecost was originally known in Hebrew as the Feast of Shauvot, one of the three feasts that God instructed that ALL males of Israelite descent must present themselves to the temple of God.

With the dispersion of Jews into the other nations when Israel was conquered for breaking God's law, there were many people of Jewish descent who made pilgrimage back to Jerusalem for the feasts. Thus, there were thousands of international pilgrims present in Jerusalem. It is into this moment that the disciples, filled with the Holy Spirit, step out into the crowds, speaking languages they had never learnt, so that the crowds of people could hear the gospel of Jesus Christ in their own language!
