The Benefit of Light

During the last 14 years of my career I worked in an office that had no windows. There were times when I'd be very busy and work most of the day without venturing outside ~ I hadn't a clue what it was like outdoors. At the end of the working day, when I walked out into the sunshine, I would suddenly feel better.

The grogginess of the day seemed to go away and I felt a strange sensation of wellbeing.

This little phenomena is just one of the benefits of light. Science tells us that we receive many health benefits from natural light:

Our bodies absorb Vitamin D which helps with bone loss and heart health; Sunlight can ward off depression and improve sleep; Best of all, this health benefit is free, all we have to do is go out into the sunlight.

With this in mind it's easy to see why God uses the illustration of light so often in the bible. Is it any wonder why light was the first thing He made during the creation of the world? (Gen. 1:3)

In John Chapter I Christ is described as the "Light". Jesus said, "I am the light of the world." (John 8:12)

Without sunlight plants don't grow so it's easy to understand that, if we're not exposed to Jesus Christ who is The Light, we won't grow spiritually. Just as our bodies need exposure to sunlight to benefit our health our spirits need exposure to the True Light so to continue our relationship with our Heavenly Father.
