**Theme: Overcoming Shame** 

Bible Reading: Genesis 3:1-13 (RSV)

"Oh you stupid idiot! What did you do that for?" a voice berates in my head. Another voice adds to the tangle of thoughts. "See, this just proves how useless you are. No one is going to want you. No one could love you. Worthless." Tears streaming down my face, I believe these voices. The voices of shame. The same voices that I expect Adam and Eve heard, hiding in the bushes, trying so desperately to cover themselves with fig leaves, afraid of being found out, afraid of punishment. Not because God is angry and vengeful, but because shame distorts the truth.

Last week, Pastor Col said that "there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus" (Romans 8:1). But how do we, as Christians, overcome the voices of shame that drown us in self-condemnation and self-hatred to find this freedom?

In 1 John 4:18 we read, "there is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear". As we have seen from Adam and Eve, fear follows shame. So, this verse might also read, "there is no shame in love, but perfect love casts out shame".



#### So how do we overcome shame?

**Firstly**, we need the Holy Spirit to bring revelation to our hearts of who God REALLY is, of His great love, mercy, and grace for us. It is only as our distorted view of God is corrected that we can begin to understand our worth and value as a dearly loved child of God.

**Secondly**, we need to speak of our shame to others. Shame keeps us bound through running and hiding in darkness and secrecy. As we choose to bring our shame into the light with a trusted friend, mentor, or counsellor, the power of shame is broken. And finding mercy, grace, forgiveness, and love, instead of rejection and punishment, is so incredibly healing.
