VISION SERIES: WEEK 3 - (CHURCH FAMILY LIFE)

Many people have lots of different ideas as to what the church is meant to look like. But in Ephesians 4, Paul actually gives us the doctrine of the church. He tells us what church life is meant to look like relationally and it's through our participation with one another that the church grows. So how does this play out??

As we mentioned on Sunday, we need to be able to look at the problems of the wider church by looking at the context we live in. The reality is that we live in a consumeristic world. We live in a capitalistic society, and we would be fools to think that this does not impact the church. The reality is, that many churches become consumeristic, and church attitude becomes all about "me". What's in it for me? What am I getting out of it? How am I being fed? Now yes, we are here for the brokenhearted. We exist to bring people to Jesus for spiritual vitality, but what Paul tells us in Ephesians 4 is that church must function as a family. Consumeristic churches put all the emphasis on the minister or the leadership doing all of the work whilst the church congregation sits back and receives. Paul tells us that churches that do this become unhealthy and don't grow. This week we are looking at Ephesians 4:7-16 and we will see how Paul gives the answer to our problem.
